

COOKIE POLICY

Below is the information regarding the use of cookies on the Platform New Ideas Generation (hereinafter also referred to as the "Site"). The information contained in this policy complements the Privacy Policy available on the footer section of the website: <https://innovationclub.tecniplast.it/>.

DATA CONTROLLER

The data controller is the company Tecniplast S.p.A., Tax Code and VAT number IT 00211030127, with registered office at Buguggiate, via Primo Maggio, n. 6 (VA) – Italy ("TECNIPLAST" or the "Controller").

WHAT ARE COOKIES

A cookie is a small amount of data that, in the form of a unique code, is sent to the user's browser by a web server and then stored on the hard drive of their computer, smartphone, and/or tablet. Cookies can be used to enable the proper use of an Internet site (so-called technical cookies) or to check the user's preferences while browsing the web to offer them advertising messages aligned with these preferences (so-called profiling cookies).

The cookies stored on the device may have a variable duration: they disappear when the browser is closed or have a longer but still limited duration. Cookies can be installed by the owner of the website being visited (so-called first-party cookies) or by other third parties (so-called third-party cookies).

WHAT COOKIES ARE USED FOR AND WHICH COOKIES ARE USED ON THIS SITE

For each of the cookies listed in the tables below, the specific function, the validity period of the cookies, and the source, whether first-party or third-party, are indicated. For third-party cookies, there is also a link to the privacy policy of the respective website.

In particular, we use cookies for the following purposes:

TECHNICAL COOKIES

These cookies allow the Site to function properly and also enable the user to enjoy the requested content and services. These cookies are necessary for the operation of the Site, and without them, some operations could not be performed or would be more complex and/or less secure.

As they are strictly necessary, they do not require the user's consent, are automatically installed upon accessing the site, and cannot be disabled.

They include:

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FUNCTIONALITY COOKIES

These cookies ensure normal navigation and use of the website (allowing, for example, to make a purchase or authenticate to access reserved areas) and allow the user to navigate based on a series of selected criteria such as language, display preferences, etc.

OTHER COOKIES

The Platform does not use any Profiling Cookie, Performance and Analytics Cookies and any other cookie other than the cookies provided above.

LEGAL BASIS FOR COOKIE USE

Consent is not necessary as the processing is based on the user's pre-contractual and contractual request to use the Site and services offered, to provide optimal navigation and usability of the Site.

HOW CONSENT IS COLLECTED

Upon first access to any page of the Site, a banner is present containing a short notice with a link to this Cookie Policy, the "Accept all" button to click if the user wants to consent to the installation of all cookies other than technical ones, as well as the "Manage cookies" button that allows the user, through a specific tool, to accept (or later deny) consent to all or - also separately, by moving the relevant sliders - to the different functionalities, third parties, and categories of non-technical cookies. It is not possible to disable technical cookies as they are necessary for the operation of the Site. To the right of the banner, there is also a command marked with a cross, the selection of which results in the closing of the banner and the continuation of navigation according to the default settings, without any cookies other than technical ones being installed.

Closing the banner by clicking the cross on its right, scrolling the page, or clicking anywhere on the Site page outside the banner does NOT constitute consent to the use of cookies other than technical ones.

The above banner will not be presented again to the user unless at least 6 months have passed since the previous presentation, except in cases where (i) the processing conditions have changed, or (ii) the technical cookies that record the choices regarding cookies have been deleted from the device, as indicated in the browser methods below.

We remind that, according to the applicable data protection legislation, cookies necessary for the functioning of the Site are not subject to consent and therefore cannot be disabled in our choice management tool. The user may be able to object through their browser settings (as indicated in the following paragraph), but the navigation experience on the Site may be less smooth.

HOW THE USER CAN MANAGE COOKIES

If the user does not want cookies to be stored or read on their device, a cookie that records the refusal will be stored on their device to allow us to record that they have opposed the use of cookies. If they also delete this technical cookie, we will no longer be able to recognize that the user has refused the use of cookies (which means that they will have to set their preferences again the next time they visit our website).

The user has the following different options to manage cookies, including blocking their use and/or deletion:



Tool "MANAGE COOKIES" The user can always and at any time express, modify, or revoke their consents regarding cookies, accessing the "manage cookies" tool at the link present in the footer of the Site.

Browser Settings The user can also object to the registration of cookies on their hard drive by configuring their browser to disable cookies. Here are the procedures offered by the main browsers:

Once on the site, by accessing the "Your choices" area, users can view the list of third-party companies (Companies) that install cookies, check the presence and activity status of the installed cookie (Status), and selectively manage consent (On/Off). By expanding the dedicated entry (Info) for each company, users can access more information about the company and reach the specific privacy and cookie policy via link.

SCOPE OF DATA KNOWLEDGE AND DISCLOSURE

Data acquired through cookies may be processed by employees and collaborators who are authorized and trained to handle:

- the Data Controller,
- the Data Processor,
- providers of IT, technical, organizational, and digital marketing services, as data processors, and
- third parties issuing non-technical cookies to whom the user has given consent.

USER RIGHTS

At any time, users can request and obtain access to their data, correction, updating, as well as request deletion, anonymization, portability, and restriction of processing. Users can also object, at any time, to the processing of their personal data and revoke the previously given consent.

To exercise their rights, besides using the above-mentioned tools for managing cookies, users can send a written communication to the Data Controller's address provided above, or write an email to privacy@tecnipplast.it.

We also remind you that you have the possibility to lodge a complaint with the relevant Data Protection Authority regarding the processing of their personal data.
